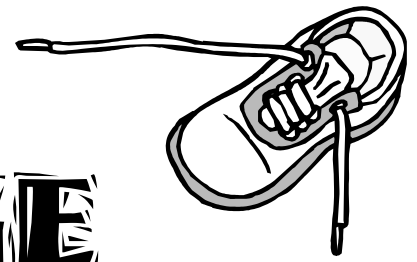


WALK FOR CHANGE



WHAT:

Walk for Change is an invitation to the people of the Holston Annual Conference to walk toward better health while raising funds for *Change for Children*.

WHY/PURPOSE:

WHEN & WHERE:

- Tuesday, June 13, 2006 – START TIME: 8:20 a.m. – Lake Junaluska
- Begin at the Rose Walk in front of Harrell Center. Walk any time between 8:20 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
Rose Walk = 0.5 miles; Around the Lake = 2.6 miles

WHO:

- Families
- Child care centers
- Youth Groups
- All ages – children, youth, adults, grandmas, grandpas, and grandfriends
- Clergy and Laity
- Church Groups (UMW, Sunday School Classes, etc.)

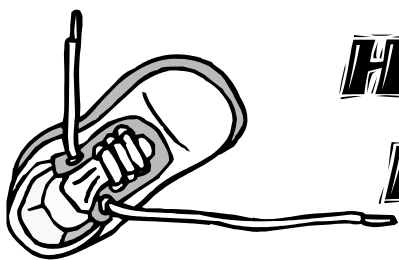
HOW:

- Check-in at the *Walk for Change* tent
- *(If you are an Annual Conference delegate, please refrain from walking during a business session.)*

The *Change for Children* program is based on the belief that the pocket change of Christians can indeed change the world for children and their families. It is a way for the entire church family to express Christian love in a tangible way.

The money collected is used for grants to support new and existing ministries with children and youth from birth through age twelve and their families who are economically disadvantaged. Half of the money stays right here in Holston Conference and half is given to Children's Ministries in Africa.
